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<u>Baby Ivy</u> is a lifelike model of a newborn head. It is specifically designed for training professionals in the practice of scalp vein catheter placement.

As a result of quality construction and the ease of replacing individual parts, this simulator should provide many years of training when reasonable care and maintenance is practiced.

Instructions for Use:


- 1. Open lid and fill blood reservoir with water.
- 2. Add blood concentrate until desired blood color is achieved.
- 3. Close valve on bleeder tube.
- 4. Close valve on pump bulb.
- 5. To pressurize system, pump bulb two or three times to slightly inflate balloon.
- 6. Release valve on bleeder tube slowly and drain fluid into a cup until all lines are free of air.
- 7. Close lid and begin procedure.

To drain system:

- I. Open valve on pump bulb.
- 2. Open valve on bleeder tube and close the lid.

The fluid will drain back into the blood reservoir.

NOTE: Before long-term storage, insert a syringe into line at end of bleeder tube and inject air to force any remaining fluid out of line and into blood reservoir.

Care and Maintenance:

- 1. Clean with mild soap and water; do not submerse in cleaning fluids or water.
- 2. Use only on clean surface. Avoid felt tipped markers, ink pens, acetone, iodine or other staining products and avoid placing the trainer on newsprint or inked lines of any kind.
- 3. To ensure longevity, trainer should be cleaned after each training session and a general inspection should be conducted regularly.
- 4. Modules and all other parts should be drained and airdried thoroughly before storage and disinfected when needed.
- 5. Articulating parts will benefit from a light application of talcum powder prior to training sessions.
- 6. Store properly between teaching sessions.
